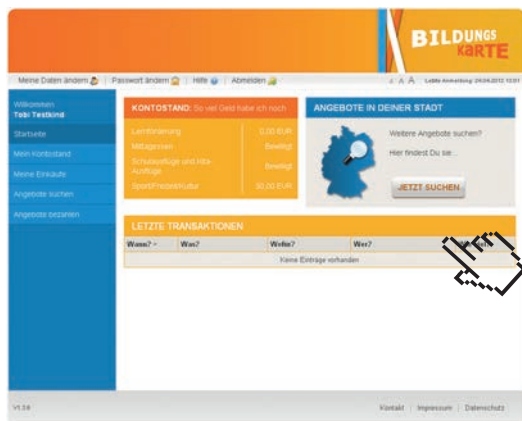


With the card number and the new password, Tobi can now register on his page for the Bildungskarte. And this is how it looks:



Here, Tobi can see what sum is available to him e.g. for membership fees, leisure activities or music lessons and which benefits have been granted for lunch or promoting learning.

Tobi passes on the card number to the provider. The provider makes the booking for him.

This is Tobi. He would reeeeeeeally love to play football for a club. But his parents are unfortunately unable to pay the membership fees because they earn little money and also receive benefits from the state. Bummer!



His friend, whose parents also receive benefits from the state, tells Tobi that the membership fees can be paid using some kind of package for education.

THAT'S RIGHT: →



School/day care trips can also be financed with the education package.

If Tobi gets bad grades in school, even his private tutoring is paid for by the state.

If Tobi has lunch at his school, his parents only have to pay one euro towards this; the rest comes from the state.

In addition to membership fees, leisure activities on offer can also be paid for with the education package.

By the way, even Tobi's little sister can get her baby swimming classes paid for.



Anyone who claims ALG II submits an application at the Job Centre; anyone who claims housing benefit (Wohngeld), child supplement (Kinderzuschlag), social security benefits (Sozialhilfe) or benefits under the Asylum Seekers Benefits Act (Leistungen nach dem Asylbewerberleistungsgesetz) submits an application to the social security office of the District of Rostock.

### And this is how it works:

Tobi's parents submit an application to the responsible office. Tobi's parents find the applications for the education package on the website at: [www.Landkreis-Rostock.de](http://www.Landkreis-Rostock.de)

For excursions and school trips, the parents must enclose evidence from the school/day-care centre. The office then pays the costs directly to the institution.

For an application for private tutoring, the parents also have to enclose a document from the school, showing that this private tutoring is necessary.

To confirm the assumption of costs for lunch, the promotion of learning and for the membership fees, leisure activities or e.g. for music lessons, Tobi gets a Bildungskarte, which looks like a bank card. With the card, Tobi also gets a letter stating that Tobi must register on the Internet at [www.bildungs-karte.org](http://www.bildungs-karte.org) with the card number and a password and must create a new password.
